Status Reports

TAC

Nothing to report. The TAC has not met and has received no contributions.

Other industry groups

Jim Baskin reported that the ITU Study Group-2 has re-approved interim procedures for e164.arpa delegations.

Robert Schafer indicated that the IETF ENUM working group is looking towards finishing up work and closing the working group.

End-user trial report update

Jim Baskin reported that the report has been transmitted to all 19 NANPA governments. No comments have been received. It is the LLC's intention to discuss the report and future activities with the US government ENUM team.

A copy of the report is available on the LLC's web site.

Jay Carpenter asked about the reference in the report to authentication issues. Jim Baskin indicated that, given the restricted test number set, only one authorization method was tested. Thus, the LLC believes further work is needed here.

Jay asked if other countries had resolved this issue.

Steve Lind indicated that the UK trial report also raised this issue and suggested more work was necessary. Robert Schafer seconded this.

Penn Pfautz suggested that the outstanding issues are with authorization rather than authentication.

LLC Initiatives

The LLC's other initiative is Provider ENUM. The Provider ENUM trial has been completed and the LLC is finalizing the report. The LLC hopes to post it to its web site around the end of the month.

Q&A

Jay Carpenter noted that the end user trial report cover letter raised the possibility of a roundtable or other meeting to address moving forward with user ENUM and asked the status of this. Jim Baskin indicated that this would depend in part on the feedback received from the US and other NANP governments.

Jay asked about plans for renewal of the 1.e164.arpa delegation before it expires in February 2008. Jim indicated any action on the part of the LLC would depend upon the discussions above. Robert Schafer indicated the delegation may also be affected by Canadian ENUM plans.

Andy Gallant asked about the status of the Provider ENUM RFP. Steve Lind indicated that the LLC is still trying to get it out in 4Q2007.
